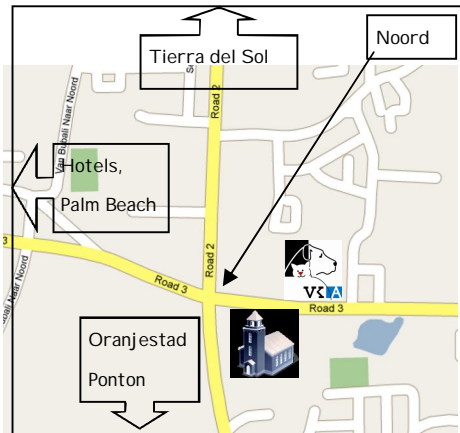

The Micro chip

What is it?

With a micro chip you can uniquely identify an animal. The chip is as big as a rice grain and is inserted with a syringe under the skin. By holding a reader over it the unique number can be read in the display

Why should I place a micro chip in my pet ?

- When traveling with your pet to another country it is used to link your pet to the health certificate
- You can register micro chips in a central database. Now if you loose your pet and somebody finds it , they can trace it back to you wherever you live !
- When pets are stolen you can always prove that you are the owner. This is particularly useful in animals who are difficult to tell apart like full breed dogs or birds.
